



2013 Member vs Nonmember attendance




2014 Member vs Nonmember attendance




We distributed 125 back packs with school supplies. The leftover supplies were placed in the clothing shelter for distribution as needed.

Essay Instructions

Students were asked to write an essay based on grade level assignment as follows:

Elementary (3rd -5th grade) – The Meaning of Christmas: Jesus Birth Middle School (6th - 8th Grade) – The Meaning of Easter: Jesus Resurrection High School (9th - 12th Grade) – Who is Jesus?

The essay should have a Title page to include: Title, writer's name, grade level and date.



Preference was for the paper to be typed, doubled space and Arial, Calibri or Times New Roman font. Neatly hand written papers were acceptable. Legibility is a must.

All essays were to be returned in to the Chair of Mission Outreach by June 29th. There were 2 late submissions, but all were accepted.

Essays were distributed to the judges for review on July 6th. Judges reviewed, scored and returned the essays to Mission Outreach Chair by July 27th.

A rubic was created and shared with each participant. The judges utilized the rubic for their scoring of papers. The scores were tabulated and averaged. The essay with the highest average is the winner. The highest point score anyone can receive is 35. The lowest score is 7.
